<b>2. Style Consistency and Readability:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. "Analyze the readability of this grant proposal and suggest improvements to make the writing clearer and more accessible?"</li> <li>2. "Review this document for consistency in writing style, make sure the tone remains formal and professional throughout the document."</li> <li>3. "Please identify any sections of this document where the transitions could be clearer or more logical. Suggest ways to make it more coherent."</li> </ol>

<b>4. Plagiarism Detection:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. "This text needs to be checked for plagiarism. Can you identify any sections that might need citations or rephrasing to avoid plagiarism?"</li> <li>2. "Scan this document for any missing or improperly cited references."</li> <li>3. "Review this draft and provide suggestions on how to rephrase or improve originality in sections that may be flagged for plagiarism."</li> </ol>
